An <u>outlaw motorcycle club</u> is a <u>motorcycle subculture</u>. It is generally centered on the use of <u>cruiser</u> motorcycles, particularly <u>Harley-Davidsons</u> and <u>choppers</u>, and a set of ideals that purport to celebrate freedom, nonconformity to mainstream culture, and loyalty to the biker group.
